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DAY 1 EXPLORE DOWNTOWN



CENTRAL MARKET

Begin your day with a walk around Ljubljana's **Central Market**. It's more than just a place to shop. Traditionally, it has been a place for the locals to meet, shop, chat and enjoy the local cuisine. Explore the indoor and outdoor market area, which is open every day except Sundays.



Try some Slovenian cuisine and have a brunch at Moji Štruklji. This "štrukljarnica" is located in Plečnik's arcade at Ljubljana's Central Market and serves up a daily range of more than 20 different types of "štruklji" - boiled strudel - with creamy or classic fillings and toppings. Treat yourself to traditional varieties such as cottage cheese, tarragon, apple or a buckwheat version with walnuts.



You can join a guided tour through Ljubljana Central Market. The yummy market walk is available on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday at 9 am and will take you on a culinary exploration of the market.

Visit **Ljubljana Castle** just uphill from the Central Market. At the castle you can get the best view of the city and it is known as a popular photo spot.



You can join a guided tour of Ljubljana. Guides focus on explaining major attractions and local life in Ljubljana, so you will get a unique and in-depth perspective. The 2-hour walking tour of the historical city centre starts at 11 am and ends with a funicular ride up to Ljubljana Castle.



Have a royal lunch at Ljubljana Castle at the restaurants **Strelec** or **Gostilna na gradu**.

The **Ljubljana River** is one of Ljubljana's most notable landmarks with its attractive bridges and picturesque old city centre embankments. The embankments are densely scattered with lively cafés offering outdoor seating, and they are the heart of Ljubljana's social life.



Stop by at **Restaurant Breg** for a feast or just a slice. It's not a bistro, it's not a tavern, Breg is an inn - the way they used to be known, but without the dustiness. A neo-inn, according to its famous chef Jorg Zupan.



A good way to see the old city centre and its famous bridges, picturesque buildings and vibrant embankments from a completely different angle is to join a tourist boat cruise along the river. In the summer you can join a sup or kayak tour and paddle through the city centre.



Be sure to find some fun and entertainment in the evening and check out all the events in Ljubljana for the time of your stay.

Start your day with great coffee at one of the cafes and bars at **Petkovškovo nabrežje embankment**. You'll have a beautiful view of the **Central Market's colonnade**, designed by the master architect.

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The multitude of his creations in the city is referred to as “**Plečnik’s Ljubljana**”, and it is considered to be one of the 20th century’s most important overall works of art. Let your exploration take you to Plečnik’s house, where the famous architect lived and worked.



Join an **epic tour** with the architect behind UNESCO’s Ljubljana. An intimate experience of the visionary master and his great mind.



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In Ljubljana, culinary adventurers will find a rich and diverse range of foods for every taste and pocket. Ljubljana's food scene is like the city itself: ancient but youthful, refined but boisterous, local but cosmopolitan.



In Tivoli Park, you can stop for lunch at Švicarija or at the nearby Pivnica Union, or you can visit Trubarjeva Street to enjoy some of the most delicious street food in Ljubljana.



Visit the **City Museum** not far from Plečnik's house to see the world's oldest wooden wheel with an axle (5,200 years old) and stop by the **National Museum** to see the oldest musical instrument in the world - a 60,000-year-old Neanderthal flute.

The biggest attraction of the **National Gallery** is its rich collection of works by Slovenian impressionists, while the **Museum of Modern Art** exhibits works by leading artists of the twentieth century.

Take a break and a breath - stroll through **Tivoli Park** just next to the galleries and museums and enjoy sharing the many pathways with walkers, runners, picnickers and the like.

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METELKOVA CITY



Exploring the city's rich artistic heritage will bring you to the **museum complex at Metelkova Ulica and to Metelkova City** - an alternative cultural centre that developed from a squat in former army barracks and that brings together a variety of different artistic practices and events.

Finish your day by tasting some local beers or wines at one of the many lively bars in the city.



For the beer lover who'd like to become familiar with the beer brewing tradition in Ljubljana and would enjoy tasting beers from different brewers in Ljubljana and its vicinity: join a guided tour of the [Ljubljana beer experience](#).

For the wine lover who'd like to taste seven premium wines from different Slovenian wine regions in the company of a sommelier and the embrace of a 300-year-old wine cellar: join an [interactive wine experience](#).
